"Little Linksters" | Age 3-6 | \$100 per month

The goal of the Little Linksters is to introduce the little ones to the game of golf in a fun learning environment.

• 3 Group Clinics (1 hr) | Students will enjoy comradery and an introduction to golf through exciting games and fun activities as they explore putting, short game, and full shots.

"Elevate" | Age 7-12 | \$200 per month

The goal of Elevate is to create a fun learning environment for juniors of all levels.

- 1 Private Lesson (45 min) Students will be evaluated in putting, short game, and full swing to determine their personal needs to improve. Drills and homework will be given and logged.
- 1 Group Clinic (1.5 hrs) | During group clinics, students will enjoy comradery and structured practice. Students will practice short game and putting with preset drills and contests, as well as full swing and team competitions. will take center stage.
- Game Day (2.5 hrs) All Elevate students will come together at the end of the month for practice, competition, and fun! Groups will rotate through different stages of putting, short game, bunker, and full shots to earn points for the first two hours before participating in a playoff.

"Elite" | Age 13+ | \$225 per month

The goal of Elite is to create a home for older, highly-skilled players interested in playing tournament golf. Participants will learn their individual tendencies and patterns within a fun yet competitive culture.

- 1 Private Lesson (1 hr) | Students will be evaluated in putting, short game, and full swing to determine their personal needs to improve. Students will learn how to execute their fully-customized practice plans. Each player will develop how to improve in every aspect of the game from technique to strategy to psychological skills.
- 2 Group Clinics (2 hrs) | During group clinics, participants will push each other in various scoring drills and games used by college golf programs across the nation. Topics will change monthly and include: Aimpoint green reading, high level scoring concepts, DECADE course management concepts, psychology of tournament golf, guest appearances from current collegiate golfers, and more.
