Our Story

In the 1990s, local attorney David Nutt acquired some 2,100 acres of what had once been the Johnstone's family estate. As Madison the city grew around it, Nutt crafted a plan to make this stretch of land a gathering place for a new generation. A master plan for the unique neighborhood that would be called Reunion was born, and the first homes were built in the 2000s.

Families were drawn to the wide range of amenities that only a property this expansive could offer, including an equestrian center, hiking and biking paths, and 400 acres of lakes stocked with fish. The centerpiece of it all was the full-scale country club, complete with a par-72 championship golf course.

Reunion Hall

The Johnstone family established the community in the late 1800s and built their home amongst the oak trees. Today, Reunion Hall still stands at the main entrance with its grand antebellum columns, welcoming residents home. A recognizable backdrop of family photos, wedding portraits and many important milestones, Reunion Hall serves as our Welcome Center and office for the POA and Developer.

GOLF CART REGISTRATION

All golf carts require registration with the POA office. Stop by Reunion Hall to fill out a form, get your sticker, and hit the road in Reunion's preferred transportation method. No private carts allowed on the golf course.

ASSESSMENTS & PID

Homeowner dues provide many services including an on site, full time POA staff, 24/7 property surveillance, private security daily from 4pm to 4am, and maintenance of the neighborhood's five gated entrances.

Dues are \$2250 for 2025 and are due in January each year. The POA offers a convenient ACH draft with the option to pay in full or pay in two installments of \$1125. Please reach out to the POA office for draft enrollment information.

The PID (Public Improvement District) is a fee that is included in your annual property tax statement from the Madison County Tax Collector. The amount of your PID is just under 1% of the original price of your lot. There are two PID districts in Reunion, one has expired for 2025 and the other will expire in 2032.





SCHOOLS

Reunion is served by the highly-acclaimed Madison County Schools. Madison County is one of the fastest growing, top-rated districts in the state, and is one of the highest scoring county school districts in Mississippi to achieve an "A" rating based on the statewide accountability model. With more than 13,000 students, Madison County is the fifth largest school district in the state of Mississippi.

Madison Station Elementary was recognized as a National Blue Ribbon School in 2020 and 2010.
